Sub.: Proficiency test in computer typing for the posts of Junior Secretariat Assistant (Gen./F&A/S&P) – reg.

The candidates who qualified in Open Competitive Written Examination for the 06 posts of Junior Secretariat Assistant (Gen/F&A/S&P) vide Notice cited at Reference.2 are hereby informed that the Proficiency test in computer typing shall take place tentatively on **04th and 05th July, 2023** at CSIR-CCMB, Hyderabad

The Scheme of the Proficiency test in computer typing and evaluation methodology is as under:

Time allowed	10 minutes
English	35 words per minute in computer (35 w.p.m. corresponds to
Typing test	10500 KDPH on an average of 5 key depressions for each
	word)
Hindi	30 words per minute in computer (30 w.p.m. corresponds to
Typing test*	9000 KDPH on an average of 5 key depressions for each
	word)

* The Hindi typing test will be conducted in 'Kruti Dev010' font.

- Criteria for Evaluation of type-scripts of typing test is as per CSIR Letter No. 5-1(116)/2011-PD dated 13.07.2015
- The methodology for calculating the accurate typing speed, i.e. upto 5% mistakes shall be ignored for UR/EWS/OBC/SC/OH/VH candidates and upto 7% mistakes shall be ignored for ST/HH/Ex. Servicemen candidates.

For example: For a typing test of 10 minutes

5% mistakes of total words typed are ignored.

Total strokes typed	:	1600
Words typed	:	1600/5 = 320
Mistakes	:	19
Ignorable Mistakes	:	5% of 320 =16
Admissible mistakes	:	19-16 = 3

As per formula : (No. of words/10)-Number of mistakes

= (320/10)-3 = 32-3 = 29 w.p.m.

- > The medium of Proficiency test in computer typing shall be in English/Hindi as opted by the candidates in their application form and any request for change of medium shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- > The proficiency test in computer typing is only qualifying in nature.
- > The instructions for PwBD candidates regarding Proficiency test in computer typing shall be as per Government of India/CSIR guidelines.
- > The Admit cards giving detailed information/instructions etc. to the shortlisted candidates will be issued in due course of time.
- The shortlisted candidates are advised to visit CSIR-CCMB website <u>https://www.ccmb.res.in</u> and <u>their respective emails</u> regularly for further updates/instructions in this matter.
